

## **General Rules and Regulations**

The rules and regulations of Camp For All are necessary to ensure a the safety of all campers.

- 1. The following are not permitted in any part of the Camp For All facility:
  - a. Fireworks
  - b. Pets PLEASE LEAVE ALL PETS AT HOME.
  - c. Camping stoves or heated cooking devices.
- 2. Camp For All is a smoke-free campus. Smoking (including "vaping") is not allowed inside any Camp For All facility or within ½ mile of Camp For All property.
- 3. Camp For All is not responsible for loss or damage to personal property.
- 4. Access to specialized program activity areas, including the Ranch, Archery, Bikes, Pool, Lake and Challenge Course, are allowed only when accompanied by a properly trained Camp For All Staff member.
- 5. Vehicles are not permitted beyond designated parking areas. Vehicles must be parked in designated areas. A maximum limit of 10 mph must be observed on camp property.
- 6. The use of personal sports equipment must be approved by the Camp Director, prior to arrival.



# **COVID-19 Rules and Regulations**

#### 1. Housing

A maximum of 18 families will be allowed to be at camp.

- 1 family per cabin at all times.
- 2. All campers and staff will have an initial screening upon arrival at camp. Families will pull up to circle drive to be checked in and screened by staff before moving into their cabins.

### 3. Dining Hall

Each family will have their own table.

Tables will be spread out for physical distancing.

#### 4. Masks

Masks will be worn by all campers and staff indoors at all times except when sitting at their table and eating.

Masks will be worn outdoors when physical distancing is unavailable. i.e. harnessing at ropes, archery instruction, loading horses, nighttime activities etc.

### 5. Evening Activities

Campfires will be in the large amphitheater with physical distancing. Families will be asked to stay in their assigned area in the amphitheater.
